**STUDENT RESEARCH ASSISTANT PROGRAM**

Students may apply to perform paid research for a faculty member during the summer or coming academic year. Faculty members wishing to work with a research assistant will be matched with student applicants by the Associate Dean of Faculty Office.

In matching faculty with student research assistant applicants, factors taken into account will include shared faculty and student research interests, relevant courses a student has completed, past work experience, and cumulative grade point average. The faculty member making the request for a research assistant will make the final choice.

Each faculty is awarded up to 200 hours of student research assistant time. Therefore, depending on faculty need, a student research assistant may earn up to \$2,400. The exact number of hours per week and the start and finish dates are to be determined by the professor, but would begin no earlier than June 1. Students will earn \$12 per hour and are required to fill out monthly time cards.

The application asks you to identify which terms, and how many hours, you would be available. Please note that indicating high availability increases your chances of being selected for significant projects.

Students not initially matched with a professor will be kept on a list that will be available if faculty need additional help during the academic year.

Students who are selected as a student research assistant will be requested to complete a one-hour advanced research training session given by our law library research staff.
