Electronic Submission at NIH: Since December 2005, NIH has systematically transitioned grant programs from paper PHS 398 application forms to electronic SF424 (R&R) application packages submitted through Grants.gov. Approximately 80 percent of all NIH competing grant applications now use the electronic process.
